

Scope Statement

Fincantieri Marinette Marine (FMM) is committed to maintaining a comprehensive Environmental, Health & Safety (EHS) Management System (MS) that will allow the company to meet all customer requirements and ISO 14001:2015 & OHSAS 18001:2007 standards.

FMM builds highly complex, technologically innovative seafaring vessels that service the most advanced naval force in the world. Operations consist of fabrication, assembly, painting, and other related activities housed in over 550,000 square feet of manufacturing, warehouse, and receiving space. The company employs cutting-edge computer-controlled manufacturing equipment and has heavy-lift capabilities to meet the most demanding requirements.

The management system provides a framework for EHS management for all operations performed at the Marinette, Wisconsin facility. The scope of the EHS system includes all manufacturing and support activities, as well as contract services performed at the location by, for or on its behalf. Specific operation boundaries are defined in facilities maps, which indicate property lines and other relevant information.

The EHS system is designed to cover environmental aspects and health and safety hazards that our organization can control and directly manage, and those that we do not directly control or manage but over which we can be expected to have an influence. Marinette operations are expected to conform to corporate policies and procedures, whether or not they are included in the scope of corporate certification or maintain certification separately.
